## Committee Reports

### Algora

- NumFOCUS staff met with Algora to discuss key concerns raised last meeting, including funding mechanisms, retaining non-profit status, and securing reduced fees.
- Matt will follow up on the specific outcomes of this meeting.

### *Insights into Images* Book

- The publishing company requested the Insight Software Consortium's Certificate of Dissolution for royalty distribution, which was successfully provided.
- This publisher interaction led to the discovery of the Anthropic Class Action lawsuit (detailed in New Business).

### NumFOCUS Platform & Leadership Updates

- **Zulip Transition:** NumFOCUS has officially moved all community communications from Slack to Zulip.
- **Board of Directors Election:** The 2025 election has concluded. The newly elected board members are Noor Aftab, James A. Bednar, and Francesca van Doorn.

### Code of Conduct

- Jon Haitz, Dženana, and Matt have successfully completed their CoC onboarding.

## New Business

### Anthropic Class Action Lawsuit

- A \$1.5 Billion proposed class action settlement has been announced regarding Anthropic's alleged use of copyrighted works downloaded from datasets like LibGen and PiLiMi.
- The book *Insight Into Images* (Terry Yoo) is explicitly included in the copyright list for this settlement.
- Council decided to submit a claim by March 30, 2026 to request eligibility for payment.

### Insight Journal Update

- A presentation deck titled "*The Insight Journal: Building the Future of Reproducible Medical Image Analysis*" was shared with the council.
